### English and Maths

We will also be looking at real life issues to do with The Great Barrier Reef and creating balanced arguments surrounding the issues.

At Ash, Cartwright and Kelsey, we are using the White Rose Maths scheme. This term there is a focus on place value and calculating using the four operations.

Each week we will also be focusing on times table and mental maths practice too.
