Dogs reminder

We are happy to be a dog friendly school. Can I please remind parents, as per our policy that:

- All visiting dogs must be on a lead that keeps the dog reasonably close to the adult who is control of them;
- Visiting dogs must not be left unsupervised on the school premises and must not be left in the sole care of anyone under the age of 18. No dog can be tied up and left unattended on or near the school site at any time dogs should be kept away from entry ways so that children have a choice whether they want to come in direct contact with dogs
- When bringing dogs on to the site, dog owners do so with an absolute understanding that their dog has no issues around children, has never displayed any aggression towards children or others and that the owner believes the dog is fully trustworthy in a school environment;
- It is understood that bringing dogs to school is a privilege, not a right and is done at the absolute discretion of the Headteacher.
