Dear Parents/Carers

We have had a great arts week in school and the children have enjoyed learning about, and exploring their own spirituality. We welcomed local artist, Bliss into school on Wednesday to share her vision for the whole school art work. A huge thanks to local carpenter, Nick Hassall, for cutting the wooden circles needed for the project – he showed great perseverance! The children have used a variety of art materials; pastels, chalks and paints and have thought about which colours represent their own spirituality. In celebration assembly this afternoon we will all share what we have learnt throughout the week. To explain how we define spirituality in our school, spirituality concerns a person's relationship with themselves, with others, with God (or the transcendent), and with nature and the environment. These four elements: self; others; transcendence and beauty form the basis of our work with children in developing a strong sense of spirituality (looking in, out, up and down). I will share photos of the finished art piece once the artist has compiled this and displayed this in the hall. What an exciting project.

Year 3 are enjoying their Forest School sessions with Mrs Barrett on Thursday afternoons. They go out in all weathers. This week they used the nature area to explore spirituality. They made nature mandalas - art with the beauty of nature (looking down).



Help Raise Funds for Our School For Free – Terracycle

Did you know you can help raise funds for our school simply by bringing in your plastic bread bags, closure tags, and any bakery plastic packaging (e.g. crumpet packets, zipper bags, plastic trays)?

Through the Warburtons Bakery Free Recycling Programme, every time we send off your recycled bread bags and bakery plastic packaging, the school earns points for each kilogram collected. Over time, these points are converted into money that is donated directly back to us. Your recycling helps provide a steady stream of income throughout the year.

Drop-off point: Terracycle bin in the main reception

Accepted: Any brand of bakery plastic packaging and bread bags/closures

Not accepted: Paper bags, wax packets, or combined paper-and-film window bag
