Our playground marking sensory circuits have been installed outside the KS1 and KS2 corridors. A big thanks to the PTFA for funding these. The goal of a sensory circuit is to help children self-regulate and prepare them for learning. Some children benefit from additional sensory input as fuel for learning - the circuits are based on the theory and principles of Sensory Integration.

We hosted our annual Spelling Bee on Tuesday morning. It was great to compete against other local schools. All the children tried amazingly hard and there were winners and runners up from each school attending – they all showed great resilience which is a very important life skill. Well done to all who took part.

Year 6 attended the Safety in Action project SALUS interactive event on Tuesday afternoon. This event invites children to learn about some of the dangers they may face as they become more independent and prepare for transition to secondary school. A number of scenarios were set up by different organisations including drugs/alcohol, resilience, personal safety, school attendance and exploitation.
