Dear Parents/Carers

As usual, we have had a very busy week in school. Owls had a visit from the Kent Archaeological society visit as part of their learning about the Vikings. The archeological team were very impressed with the children's knowledge. Hawks' latest science inquiry has been "Do sugary drinks decay teeth?" Using eggshell to represent tooth enamel, they placed eggs into 4 different liquids - water, Coca-Cola, milk and orange juice to find out which would affect the eggshell the most. They concluded that the orange juice had caused the most damage to the eggshell. The Coca Cola had also removed an outer layer of the eggshell and stained it dark brown, leading to Hawks' evaluation that drinking too many sugary drinks does damage and decay teeth. Children in Magpies weighed runner bean seeds before planting them in our garden, whilst others weighed some fruit and pasta. I hope their seeds grow!

This week we have once again taken part in the NSPCC's Speak out, Stay safe Programme. Speak out, Stay safe is for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse. Children are taught to speak out if they are worried, either to a safe adult or Childline.

'Trolls' Film night on Tuesday afternoon was a great success – a huge thanks to the PTFA for making this such a lovely event for the children.
