Message from Mrs Turner

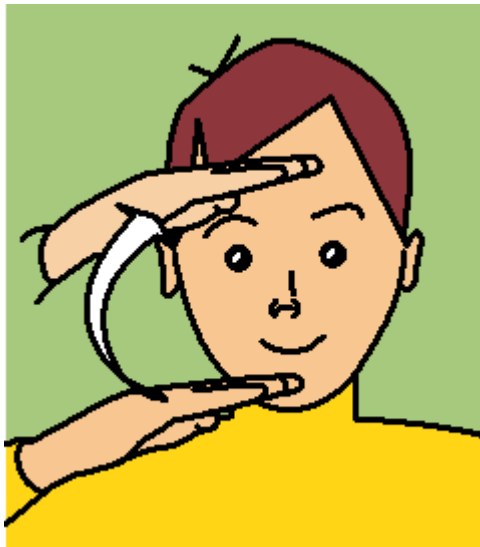
Dear Robins' parents
