1. Welcome by Chair

Introduction to meeting and welcome to Fiona Crascall.

- Chair stated that the minutes from last year reflect the same emphasis we have this year which will be to support the recovery curriculum and offer enrichment activities.
- Chair gave overview of the PTFA which is a group of volunteers who arrange fund raising activities.
- Key ethos is to support and work together with the school to assist in delivering the school plan.
- Endeavour to provide continuous enrichment to children's school life, including through Covid lockdowns.
- Thank you to staff and parents who took part in sports challenges to raise money
- Chair acknowledged the impact of matched funding and thanked Barclays Bank for their support.
- Flyer was circulated summarising some of the key deliverables in 2022/2023

2. Treasurer's report

Apologies from Treasurer.

- Chair presented report, as supplied by Treasurer (see separate document), which
 included a comment around the impact of Covid and thanks for support through the
 pandemic, acknowledgment of the importance of matched funding
- Due to the hard work of the committee members and helpers, plus the generosity of the community and Barclays Bank (who again provided matched funding) we were able to raise in excess of £20,000 of much needed funds to support the school.
- Including £3928.27 from the London Marathon fundraiser (Mr Dunn) and the 3 Peaks
 Challenge (Mr Hayes, Mr Hart) and these funds part funded a MUGA pitch for the school

3. Welcome from Head Teacher - Fiona Crascall

Headteacher explained that we are in a time of increasingly diminished & squeezed funds and the PTFA plays a vital role in delivering a broad and balanced curriculum via the school plan. Funds requests from the school all tie back into this plan to benefit the children.

Funds raised by the PTFA provide activities or resources that tie in with:

- Recovery Curriculum for example ensuring that children don't miss out on trips.
- Cultural Capital" in OFSTED terms this is "what do children experience that they may not otherwise get by enhancing life skills and wellbeing and making sure they are ok to learn.
- Enquiry based curriculum developing the enquiring mind and encouraging discussion.
 All topics start with a question.
- Encouraging positive mindsets, behaviour and language. Metacognition (thinking about thinking) and taking responsibility - there are displays in school to help children learn about this.
- Outdoor learning
- Diverse curriculum
- Themed days & guest speakers
- Raising the profile of the school within the local community

All featured in the school plan including this year new focuses on rewarding children when they do the right thing, resilience (being the best you can be), house teams (building these beyond sports day), links with school(s) in different countries, support of ECT's and renewing play equipment.

The above are also key elements of the church ethos of the school.
