Year 2 visited Sandwich Bird Observatory as part of their 'How can we protect the creatures that live in around Ash?' topic on Tuesday. They had fantastic fun learning how to make bee and bug houses. Year 1 explored the Turner Art Gallery in Margate on Wednesday and thoroughly enjoyed their art workshop and afternoon on the beach. Year 3 visited Margate Caves on Thursday as part of their Stone Age topic and had the opportunity to recreate Stone Age paintings. The Caves were originally dug as a chalk quarry in the 17th and 18th centuries and are 94.2m long and 12.2m tall at the highest point. They originally opened to the public in 1863, Owls also had a wonderful afternoon playing on the sandy beach and enjoyed an ice cream. We finish off our exciting week with year 4 visiting Wingham Wildlife Park today as part of their Rainforest topic. We are blessed to have such a wide range of places to visit within our area and really make the most of visiting these.

We are pleased to welcome a student teacher in year 1. Miss Swain is completing a PGCE and will be with Robins until term 6. She already feels very welcome and is looking forward to her placement.
