How Old is Ancient Egypt?

English and Maths



For our English lessons will be researching and finding information about Ancient Egypt; where it is, how we know about it and how King Tutankhamun's tomb was discovered. Different texts we will be studying and writing will include a newspaper report, a journal, and an adventure story.

In Maths this term there is a heavy focus on fractions. This is one of the trickier areas of maths and so we will be spending quite a few weeks on it. We will also be doing geometry; coordinates and shape transformations.

Each week we will also be focusing on times table and mental maths practice too.
