### English and Maths

Our English lessons will be linked to our topic this term as always. We will be finding out about the amazing country of India through a fictional text called 'When the Mountains Roared'. This will link into our topic sessions which will be rich in geography and history learning. Different texts we will be studying and writing will include fictional writing in a diary form and descriptive narrative, as well as a fact file and a biography.

In Maths this term, we will be learning about shape, angles, measurement with converting units and area and perimeter.

Each week we will also be continuing with daily arithmetic practice too.




### Home Learning

Home learning outcomes were again fantastic last term and I hope that the children will continue to enjoy the variety of tasks set for Term 4.

Statutory tests will be taking place in term 5 and I encourage revision of maths and grammar concepts, especially those which the children are finding tricky to understand or remember.

Support with reading with your child at home daily, times tables on TTRS, as well as encouraging the use of Spelling Shed at home to help learn the weekly spelling rules, will also aid SATs revision.

### PE
