Climate zone cards:

Highland

Here the weather changes constantly due to the height of the mountains.

It might be sunny and warm at the bottom of the mountain, however, as you walk up the mountain, the weather can become cloudy.

Highland weather involves wind, rain, snow, cloud and sunshine.

Do you think many people live in the highland areas in India?

Humid sub-tropical

Here the weather is usually very humid and hot. It only cools down for a few months of the year. It rains quite regularly which causes the air to be sticky and warm.

This climate usually experiences strong storms such as hurricanes and tornadoes.





Arid

Here it is very dry all year round with hardly any rain. Temperatures are very high during the day and drop close to (or below) freezing in the night.

There is usually less than 10 inches of rainfall over a whole year.

Semi-arid

Here the weather is dryish with warm temperatures. This climate region is found on the edges of the arid climate.

Sometimes the weather can be hot and dry and other times it can be cool and moist. It does rain in this area, usually in the winter months.

Tropical wet

Here it is hot all year round and has lots of rain. The air is usually sticky and humid. Temperatures in this area stay the same and direct sunlight is always present in this region.

Rainfall is heavy in this area and it usually rains in the morning and afternoon. The hot weather and the rain makes the air feel very moist. What kind of animals might live in the rainforests in India?



Tropical wet and dry

Here the weather changes from hot and dry to hot and wet as the year goes on. The wet season is the summer and the dry season is the winter.


Temperatures in this area stay high all year round even in the winter. Rainfall occurs in the summer months and is usually named the monsoon season.







Climate Regions Map




Challenge:

Monsoons in India

A monsoon is a strong seasonal wind that occurs in South-East Asia. The wind changes direction due to different air pressure. The result of this is extreme **wet** weather and extreme **dry** weather.

In India, from June to September, the wet monsoon occurs. Rain and storms are constant during this time and it can rain for days and days. The weather is very unpredictable. It can be sunny one minute then rain heavily, for hours, the next.

The wet monsoon in India is known as the summer monsoon.

Sometimes the summer monsoon in India is very severe. The wind can bring harsh thunderstorms, large hail storms, strong tornadoes and hurricanes.

Low lying villages and towns along the coast of India have been destroyed by these storms and some people have died as a result.



Many cities in India experience **flooding** due to the large amount of rainfall during the monsoon. This causes problems for farmers, as their crops get washed away. Floods can also destroy homes.



Not all monsoons in India are severe. Some areas of India have light rainfall during the monsoon months, which doesn't cause a problem.
