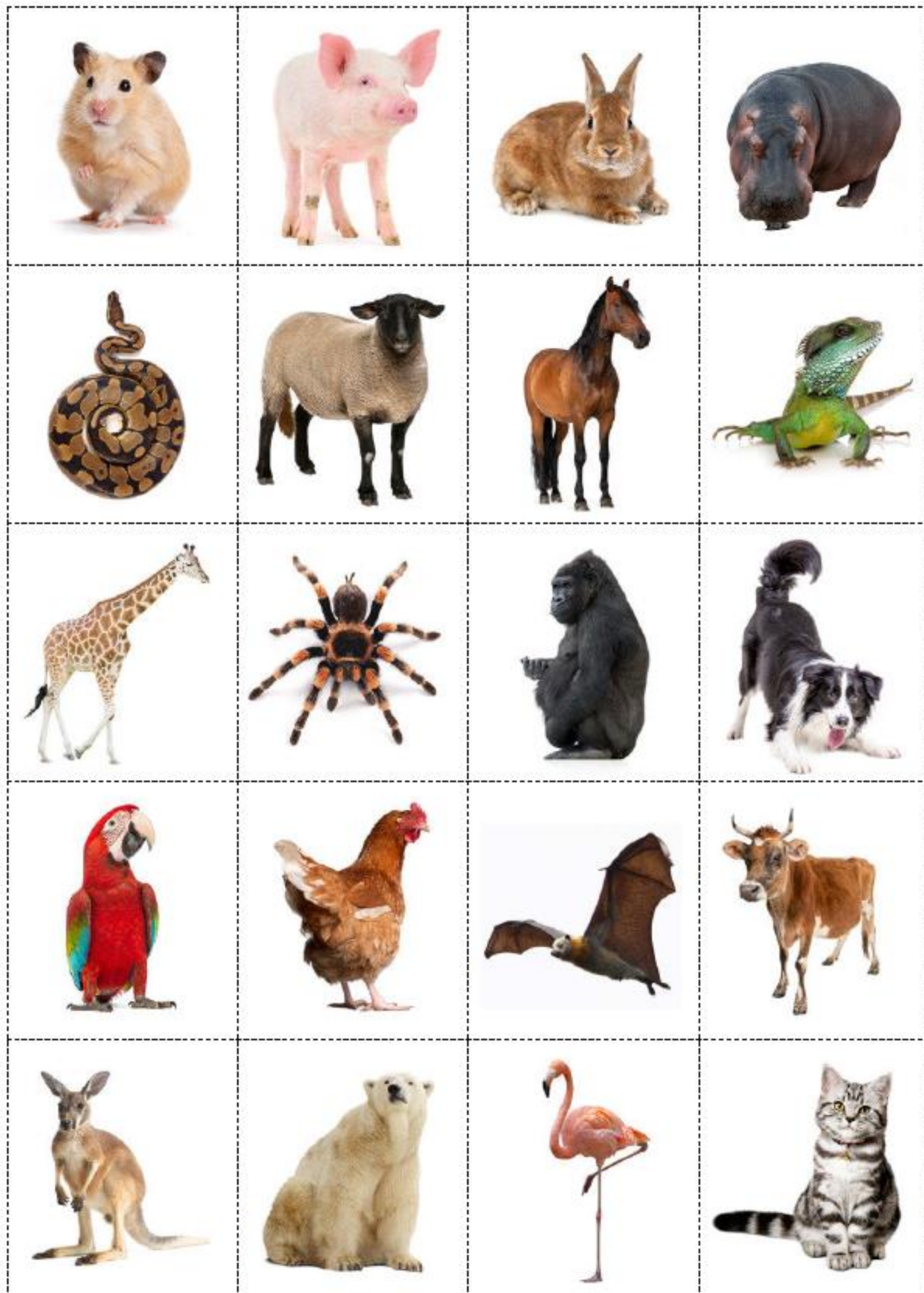

<p>MAMMALS</p> <p>Mammals are vertebrates. They give birth to live young and feed them with milk. They have fur or hair, and are warm-blooded.</p>	<p>BIRDS</p> <p>Birds are vertebrates. They have feathers and wings. Most, although not all, can fly. They lay eggs and are warm-blooded.</p>	<p>REPTILES</p> <p>Reptiles are vertebrates. They have scales and dry skin. They usually lay eggs, although some give birth to live young. They are cold-blooded.</p>	<p>ARACHNIDS</p> <p>Arachnids are invertebrates. They are wingless, with a body divided into two parts. They have eight legs and no antennae. They are cold-blooded.</p>	<p>INSECTS</p> <p>Insects are invertebrates. They have a body that is divided into three parts, with six legs and two antennae. They are cold-blooded.</p>
