Get an adult or a big brother or sister to read the words to you.</p>	<p><u>LI: To publish a piece of writing.</u></p> <p>First, choose your favourite setting description. Did you do best describing the harbour or the labyrinth? Then, go through and edit your writing, get some help to make sure you've included capital letters, full stops and corrected spellings. Then, as long as your parchment is dry, you can use a pen to neatly write out your description on the parchment. When you're done, you could even rip some corners to make it look even older!</p>	<p>Quiet reading for 20 minutes</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>KQ: What stories did Greek pottery tell?</p> <p>The Ancient Greeks used their pottery to tell stories, and also to show what daily life was like. Can you tell what is happening on the vase examples? Moving on from your drawing last week, this week you should create a silhouette of a Greek Vase design using coloured paper.</p> <p>Use a light colour to make a vase shape, then use a dark colour to cut out silhouette patterns and a scene. You could do the same design as last week, or a different design.</p>
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
