Setting Description

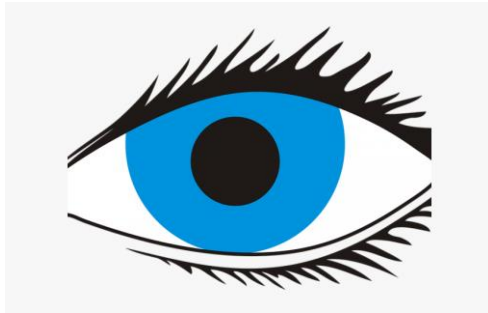
