Year 1 Weekly Home Learning Overview

Week beginning: 8th February 2021

Weekly Maths Tasks

Monday- To count in 2's: Today we are continuing to practice counting in our 2's. Watch this video to help you practice <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OCxvNtrcDIs>. Once you feel confident, have a go at today's activity, use your work from Friday to help you (your highlighted 2's).

Tuesday- To use our 2's to find missing numbers: Today you are going to use the knowledge of your 2 times table to try and fill in the missing numbers. I have included two activities one easier and one harder, you chose depending on how confident you feel with your 2's.

Wednesday- To count in 5's: Today we are going to start counting up in 5's to help us learn our 5 times tables. This can be tricky so don't worry if you haven't remembered them by the end of today (I'm not expecting you too). Have a go at today's activity and see how you get on.

Thursday- To count in 5's: Today we are continuing to practice counting in our 5's. Watch this video to help you practice <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=amxVL9KUmq8>. Once you feel confident, have a go at today's activity, use your work from yesterday to help you (your highlighted 5's).

Friday- To use our 5's to find missing numbers: Today you are going to use the knowledge of your 5 times table to try and fill in the missing numbers. I have included two activities one easier and one harder, you chose depending on how confident you feel with your 5's.

I have included answer sheets for all work sheets.

Weekly English Tasks

This week we are going to be writing a setting description by imagining we are Percy the Park keeper. A setting description is when you describe a setting using all of the senses. At the beginning of the week, we will be gathering information which will help us write our setting description at the end of the week. I cannot wait to read your setting descriptions.

(Activities sheets have been attached)

Monday- To imagine what Percy would see: Today I want you to imagine you are Percy looking out over the park, what can you see? Remember to use descriptive language, use the picture prompts and adjective word mats to help you.

Tuesday- To imagine what Percy would hear: Today I want you to imagine you are Percy looking out over the park, what can you hear? Remember to use descriptive language, use the picture prompts and adjective word mats to help you.

Wednesday- To imagine what Percy would smell: Today I want you to imagine you are Percy looking out over the park, what can you smell? Remember to use descriptive language, use the picture prompts and adjective word mats to help you.

Thursday- To imagine what Percy would touch: Today I want you to imagine you are Percy and you go for a walk around the park, what do you touch? Remember to use descriptive language, use the picture prompts and adjective word mats to help you.

Friday- To write a setting description: Today we are going to use all our work from throughout the week and write our setting description. Read my example to give you an idea of what to do. I can't wait to read them!
